## NUCLEAR EXPOSURE

Radiation exposure and safe working conditions are regulated by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and by the specific generating stations.

Brieser Construction Co. is committed to complying with the regulations and safety rules that are established by these agencies.

NRC regulations require the utilities to notify workers of their individual exposure and, it is the individual workers responsibility to maintain these records. Brieser Construction Co. will also keep a record of the employees nuclear work history, < sites and dates >. However, exposure records of the individual workers are not accessible to the company. It is extremely important that the individual worker maintain these files and be able to present them at the job site and also upon request by the company.

Nuclear workers are required to have annual physical examinations and drug screens when entering a new nuclear station. Fingerprinting and FBI checks may also be required as mandated by the customer.

Brieser Construction Co. will strictly follow client safety procedures in all NRC matters.
