STANDARD PROCEDURES FOR AN OSHA INSPECTION

Preparation for Inspection - Notify Safety Director immediately. The Safety Director will notify site owner and other potentially affected contractors and will coordinate the inspection.

- Request to see the compliance officer's credentials and document his/her name.
- Inquire as to the reason for the visit.
 - Employee complaint
 - o General or scheduled inspection
 - o Referral
 - Fatality or catastrophe investigation

INSPECTION PROCEDURES

- Opening Conference
 - Is to inform management of OSHA's purpose and identify the scope of the inspection.
 - The representative should begin taking notes.
 - o The Safety Director will be the management's representative.
 - Be prepared to show the compliance officer the OSHA 200 & 300 Logs, OSHA 300A, 1st Report of Injuries and OSHA poster.
 - o Be knowledgeable of what is contained in the safety manual.

Walkaround

- o Try to correct any violation immediately, if possible.
- If the inspection is the result of a specific employee complaint or targeting a specific work area or task, walk the compliance officer via the most direct route to the designated area only.
- Walk to the job site with the compliance officer and take notes.
- Note any areas where pictures are taken by the compliance officer. Take pictures every time the compliance officer takes pictures.

Note: Site owner must authorize the taking of any pictures.

Closing Conference

- The compliance officer will review all violations.
- o Take good notes pertaining to alleged violations.
- o Be certain as to the time allowed for abatement of the alleged violation.
- o Do not argue with the compliance officer.
