



Quarterly Cord Inspections – Week of 12/28/25 – 1/03/26



The month of January begins the First quarter of our calendar year. The beginning of a new quarter creates some inspections that must be done on our electrical equipment to make sure our chords, whether extension or attached to a tool or piece of equipment, are functioning properly and in good working condition. Section 28 of our safety manual is where you will find in detail Brieser's policy on working with and inspecting our chords and electric tools. There is where you will find it is stated that all electric cords must be tested for continuity, condition, and GFCI's must be tested for proper function. Once those inspections and tests are completed, the individual who performed the inspection will place colored tape at one of the ends of the chord to signify this chord or tool has passed the quarterly inspection process. **January 1 – March 31 = White!**

Remember to continue to do daily inspections, looking for wear or damage that will prevent you from using that chord and placing it out of service.
